CYCLING ITEMS NEEDED FOR OUR EVENT

1. **IMPORTANT ITEM NEEDED FOR YOUR SAFETY: CYCLING LIGHTS FOR BEST VISIBILITY. THESE WILL BE USED IN OUR DEPARTURE AT 5:00AM ON FRIDAY NOVEMBER 11.**
2. EMERGENCY TOOLS (MULTI TOOL), TUBES, SPARE TIRES, REAR RED LIGHT, WATER BOTTLES, CHAIN OIL, GLOVES, HELMET, SHOES, ADDITIONAL BIB, SOCKS, SUNGLASSES, RAIN JACKET AND SUNSCREEN LOTION.
3. COPY OF YOUR ID WITH YOUR CONTACT PERSON INFORMATION IN THE EVENT OF EMERGENCY AND YOUR MEDICAL CONDITION (IF ANY) IN A PAPER SAVED IN (ZIP LOCK BAG) RECOMMENDED TO TAKE IT WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES. IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT, WE KNOW WHO TO CONTACT IMMEDIATELY.

IMPORTANT PERSONAL ITEMS



CREAM, CONTACT LENSES, EYEGLASSES, DEODORANT, TOOTHBRUSH, TOOTHPASTE, HAIRBRUSH, RAZORBLADE, SHAVING CREAM, CELL PHONE CHARGER, PREVENTIVE MEDICATIONS, CASH MONEY, CREDIT CARD AND DRIVER LICENSE.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND RULES FOR ALL CYCLISTS :

1. **Alcoholic beverages will not be allowed during the course of our event.**
2. **Earphones, photos or selfies are not allowed in the peloton while participating in our event.**
3. **Triathlon Bikes (TT) are not allowed.**
4. **There will be no cut-off or removal of any cyclist. This is a charity event but a high-performance event. If for any reason any cyclist is staying too far from the peloton you will have to board our official escort or your personal escort until you reach our next official stop where you can re-integrate to our event.**
5. **Any personal escort will be able to participate in our event but must be kept at all times behind our official vehicles and official escorts.**
6. **No Cyclist can pass their assigned peloton captains. If you do you will be ejected of our event.**
7. **To maintain an order suited in both pelotons we need for every cyclist please ride in 2 by 2 file structure. For everyone's safety.**
8. **Your punctuality is necessary at the moments of departure of our event.**

LUGGAGE COLLECTION

On the day of departure, Friday November 11, there will be a designated vehicle, in which all participants will put their luggage. That vehicle closes and doesn't reopen until our arrival in Ponce. Once in Ponce, that vehicle will go hotel by hotel, handing out luggage. They must be well identified, including the hotel tag and the correct drop off information. **UNIDENTIFIED EQUIPMENT WILL NOT BE TRANSPORTED.**

On Sunday November 13, the departure is at 6:30am, the same vehicle will go hotel by hotel, picking up luggage from 5:00am, breakfast will be ready and cyclists must be at the Plaza Las Delicias in Ponce from 5:00am to 6:00am for breakfast. **Departure for (Peloton B will be at 6:30am) and (Peloton A will depart at 7:30am).** Once again, the vehicle closes and does not reopen until Mayaguez. In Mayaguez, the arrival is at the Plaza Litoral de las Banderas where there will be lunch. After lunch, the vehicle will go hotel by hotel handing out your luggage.

On Sunday November 13 **(Peloton B will depart at 6:00am) and (Peloton A will be at 7:30am)** The assigned vehicle will go to each hotel collecting your luggage from 4:30am so that the cyclists are ready for punctual



Departures with their respective peloton. The vehicle cargo area will be sealed until it's arrival in the Department of Recreation and Sports in San Juan for participants luggage pick up.

NOTE: We will only deliver your luggage to official hotels, not residences, or Air B&B's, so they must coordinate transportation to the respective locations. Cyclists who are in hotels, not residences, nor Air B&B's will be transported in the official vehicles of the event will pick them up in the morning.

In Mayaguez there will be buses courtesy of Mayaguez Municipality which will transport the cyclists to the hotels with their bicycles and them pick up in the morning the following day. It is important to be in the lobbies for the collection of the participants. In previous years the hotel designated an area and luggage was collected there if the cyclist was cyclist picked up first.
